Will Gonzalez, Executive Director of Ceiba, a coalition of Latino community based organizations serving Eastern North Philadelphia, was formerly the executive director of the Police Barrio Relations Project. He has received numerous awards including the Civil Rights Award from Governor Tom Ridge's Advisory Commission on Latino Affairs. A former staff attorney at Friends of Farmworkers, he is being honored for all his public service, particularly to the Latino community, and his work on racial and ethnic bias in the justice system.

Yvette Long, immediate past President of the Pennsylvania Legal Aid Network, Inc.'s Board of Directors, is a long time advocate for legal services clients. She is the Chair of several Department of Public Welfare Committees, including the Employment and Training Committee. She has also been a leader of the Pennsylvania Welfare Rights Organization for many years. She is being honored for all her work in support of legal aid programs, including Friends of Farmworkers, to further access to the justice system for all Pennsylvanians, including the poor.

Thomas G. Wilkinson & Cozen O'Connor, Member of Cozen O'Connor, has a long and distinguished record of public service.
